



# Raptor Nationals

## General Information

March 4-10, 2018

<b>Start / Finish</b>	This event will be leaving from Western Trails Ranch at 37838 W Grand Ave, Morristown, AZ 85342, and stopping in Laughlin, NV for the night. Tuesday we will start in Laughlin and end in Las Vegas, NV at Hogs and Heifers / the Grand. The entire trail is about 315 miles.
<b>Registration</b>	Registration is open Sunday, March 4 <sup>th</sup> from 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm at Western Trails Ranch where you may pick up your registration packets. There is a late registration from 6:00 am to 8:00 am at Western Trails Ranch on Monday morning. Once you receive it, please wear your wristbands at all times during the event.
<b>Registration Fees</b>	Registration fees are \$1,500 per vehicle which includes the driver and one passenger. Each additional passenger is \$585 (includes t-shirt and dinner). A single driver in a truck is \$1,235. Children 10 and under are free (up to 2 children) but will not have access to VIP areas. Registration is available on our website, and you may pay by credit card through the link to Paypal from our registration page.
<b>Accommodations</b>	Tropicana Hotel and Casino included in your package for Monday night. Group Code for the Grand in Las Vegas. We will reserve your room in Laughlin, you are responsible for any accommodations in Las Vegas.
<b>FM Radio</b>	We will be using FM race style radios and our official channel will be 152.960 (Rugged Relay).
<b>Terrain</b>	Fast fire roads, twisty tight mountain roads, high desert roads lined with Joshua trees, white sand wash roads and some really fun pavement sections are to be expected on this adventure.
<b>Really Important Mumbo Jumbo</b>	You will not be allowed at any event without proper credentials including all Five 2 Production functions such as the Kickoff Party, Happy Hour, Tropicana Hotel, etc. You will not be let into the VIP area without the proper VIP pass which will be included in your final packet. Participants will not be allowed into designated parking areas without your parking pass affixed to your front windshield. This ensures that everyone has signed the liability waiver which means that Five 2 Productions, our sponsors, affiliates and other participants of this event will be held harmless for your choices and corresponding actions. We will be driving off-road. Please use good judgment for <b>ALL</b> aspects of this adventure. <b>THIS IS NOT A RACE!!!</b> There will be a support truck in the rear to ensure that everyone makes it out safely. We will be traveling entirely on public roads. We will travel at a moderate pace to ensure your enjoyment, but we must observe all posted speed limits when on graded dirt roads. <b>NO EXCEPTIONS!!!</b>
<b>Safety Equipment</b>	All participants should carry at least 32 ounces of drinking water per person at the start of the rally. All vehicles must have a minimum of a lap belt restraint system or the stock 3-point seat belt, but a 4- or 5-point restraint system is highly recommended. We strongly suggest that all vehicles carry a spare tire, tools, oils and chemicals, first aid kit, tow strap, jack, FM race style radio, GPS and fire extinguisher.
<b>Public</b>	This event is on public lands and roads and you are not being charged for the driving portion of the event. Anyone may participate in the guided tour only without incurring costs.
